Please Practice Kite Safety

1. All Kite fliers must stop at Registration Tent to sign a waiver and get a wristband.
2. The safest places to fly are clear, open spaces away from buildings, people, power lines, roadways and kite-eating trees. Do not fly kites in the parking areas or designated no-fly zones.
3. If your line gets tangled in power lines DO NOT try to remove it. Instead, contact a Safety Marshall for assistance.
4. There is a 500' line limit throughout the Voice of America Park.
5. Do not fly in stormy weather, especially if lightning is present.
6. Do not enter the Big Kite area. Large kites pull extremely hard. Keep away from all of the lines.
7. Be sure to give people, animals and other kite fliers enough space. Sport kites can reach speeds of over 100 m.p.h.. Please be responsible and never dive or swoop your kite over people or animals.
8. When kite lines get crossed, the tangled fliers should walk toward each other. The tangle should slide down the line to the fliers and be easily undone. Introduce yourself, you have made a new flying friend.
